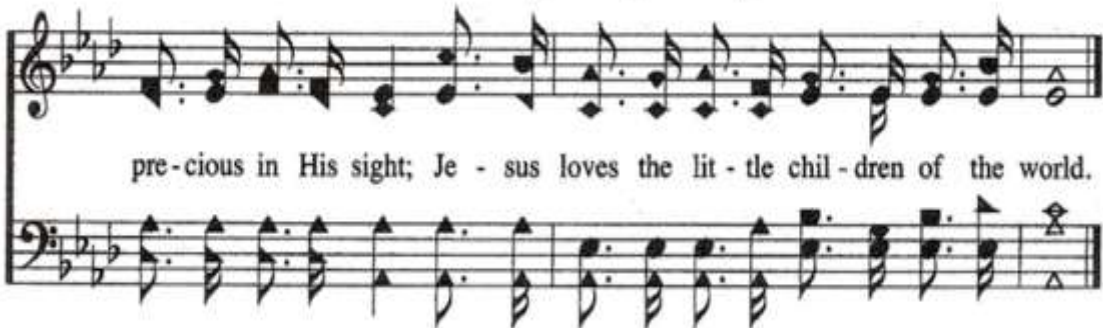

John 20:1–9 (NIV)

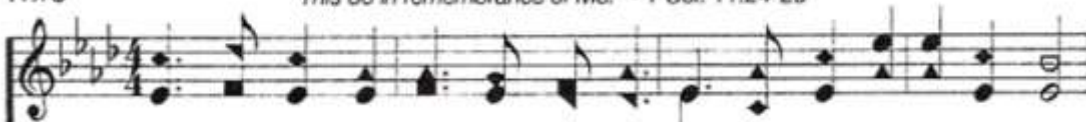

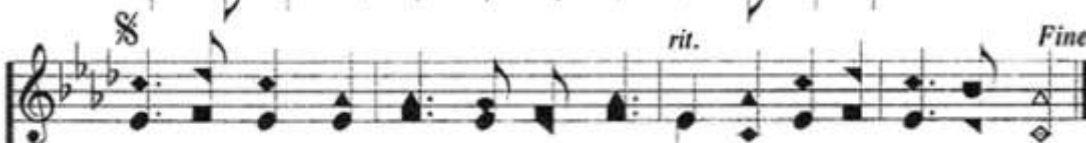
