

	a. Proverbs 3:5: Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding				
	b. Each day we must intentionally lay aside our own plans and expectations—and surrender to His plans.				
	c. What about those times I don't want to SURRENDER to God's plan?				
II.	Pray to the Lordto God with your thoughts & words				
	a. Proverbs 3:6: "in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight"b. Psalm 55:17 "Evening, morning, and noon I cry out in distress, and he hears my voice."				
III.	Run from Evil. We must ourselves from the bad influences that keep dragging us down.				
	a. 1 John 2:15-17 (The Message) ¹⁵⁻¹⁷ Don't love the world's ways. Don't love the world's goods. Love of the world squeezes out love for the Father. Practically everything that goes on in the world—wanting your own way, wanting everything for yourself, wanting to appear important—has nothing to do with the Father. It just isolates you from him. The world and all its wanting, wanting, wanting is on the way out—but whoever does what God wants is set for eternity.				
IV.	Put God First in Your Life. Stop being Self!				
	a. Matthew 6:33: ³³ But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.				

b. **Proverbs 3:9-10**: Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; then your barns will be filled to over flowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine.

V. Check Yourself; Hold Yourself ______ by God's Word

- a. **Proverbs 3:11:** My son, do not despise the LORD's discipline and do not resent his rebuke.
- b. **Psalm 119:11:** I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.
- c. Let's be honest. We aren't so good at evaluating ourselves. We will go to great lengths to excuse our behavior, our actions, and our sins. Who needs a defense attorney when we can pretty much find a reason for any bad thing we do? The prophet **Jeremiah in Chapter 17:9** captures this very well: "The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?

VI. Listen to the _____.

- a. **John 14:26:** But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.
- b. 2 Timothy 1:14: Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you—guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us.

VII. Rest in God's Love; Never forget that _____ ____

- a. In Proverbs 3:12: Solomon reminds us that God never takes a break or leaves us to fend for ourselves: "because the LORD disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in.
- b. Even in the midst of turmoil, God sticks with us and uses those challenges to shape us.
- c. No longer do we see our setbacks as failures; we see them as moments when God, as our loving Father, works on us.

Text: John 6:60-69


Have someone read text then someone tell the story in his/her own words.
