

¹ The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel:
² for attaining wisdom and discipline; for understanding words of insight;
³ for acquiring a disciplined and prudent life, doing what is right and just and fair;
⁴ for giving prudence to the simple, knowledge and discretion to the young-⁵ let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance-⁶ for understanding proverbs and parables, the sayings and riddles of the wise.
⁷ The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.

1 Kings 3:1-15 (NIV)

[¬] Solomon made an alliance with Pharaoh king of Egypt and married his daughter. He brought her to the City of David until he finished building his palace and the temple of the LORD, and the wall around Jerusalem. ² The people, however, were still sacrificing at the high places, because a temple had not yet been built for the Name of the LORD. ³ Solomon showed his love for the LORD by walking according to the statutes of his father David, except that he offered sacrifices and burned incense on the high places.

⁴ The king went to Gibeon to offer sacrifices, for that was the most important high place, and Solomon offered a thousand burnt offerings on that altar.




