


HOW WE GOT HERE

(A brief history of North Tampa) - Neal Pharr

SONG: WE DECLARE THAT THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS HERE (604) – JAN BLACKWELL

SCRIPTURE: EPHESIANS 4:1-7

NEAL PHARR - LEADER: IN THE 4TH CHAPTER OF EPHESIANS, PAUL

WROTE: I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called,

RESPONSE: with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

LEADER: There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call—

RESPONSE: one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

ALL: But grace was given to each one of us according to the measure of Christ's gift.

WHERE WE ARE

(The state of the congregation) – Shepherd talk by Kris Kent SONG: THEY'LL KNOW WE ARE CHRISTIANS (112) – CRAIG JOHNSON

SCRIPTURE: EPHESIANS 4:11-16

Kris Kent: LEADER - LET US CONTINUE TO READ FROM EPHESIANS 4

LEADER: And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds^[c] and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ,

ALL: until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,

LEADER: so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes.

ALL: Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love.

WHERE WE'RE GOING

(The vision for the future) – Shepherd talk by John Shack Shackelford

SONG: I LOVE THY KINGDOM LORD (731)

RICHARD HAMMONDS SCRIPTURE: JOHN 17:1-26

LEADER (Shack): When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, ² since you have

given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. ³ And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. ⁴ I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do. ⁵ And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.

ALL "I have manifested your name to the people whom you gave me out of the world. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. ⁷ Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you. ⁸ For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me. ⁹ I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours.

LEADER: All mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them. ¹¹ And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one. ¹² While I was with them, I kept them in your name, which you have given me. I have guarded them, and not one of them has been lost except the son of destruction, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.

ALL: But now I am coming to you, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

LEADER: I have given them your word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

ALL: I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. ¹⁶ They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

LEADER: Sanctify them^[b] in the truth; your word is truth. ¹⁸ As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. ¹⁹ And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be sanctified^[d] in truth.

ALL "I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, ²¹ that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

LEADER: The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one,

ALL: I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

PRAYER: Shack - AS WE LOOK TO THE FUTURE, LET US PRAY THAT WE WILL WORK TOGETHER TO FULFILL THESE WORDS OF JESUS THAT WE HAVE JUST READ TOGETHER

<u>Will</u> – **LEADER** And when the hour came, he reclined at table, and the apostles with him. ¹⁵ And he said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. ¹⁶ For I tell you I will not eat it [b] until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."

ALL: And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

ALL: ²⁰ And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood **Prayer for the fruit of the vine – Will**
