

Scripture Reading

James 1:2-3 in The Message translation

"Consider it a sheer gift, friends, when tests and challenges come at you from all sides. You know that under pressure, your faith-life is forced into the open and shows its true colors."

And here's another New Testament verse that exemplifies a similar message of enduring trials and challenges:

Romans 5:3-4 NIV

"We also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope."

 - Psalm 102:27 assures us, "But you remain the same, and your years will never end."
 - Trust in His wisdom, goodness, and faithfulness, knowing that He is in control regardless of our circumstances. Remember, God's Got This.

- <u>Jeremiah 29:11</u> reminds us, "For I know the plans I have for you... plans to prosper you and not to harm you." Even in the midst of trials, God's purpose remains.
 - Embrace His plan and serve Him faithfully.
 Serving God in a world of challenges means finding peace in His plans.

- Hebrews 11:1 defines faith as "confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."
 - Let your faith be your anchor, It can sustain you through the darkest times. Be in the Word of God.
 It will enable you to continue serving God with determination.
- Romans 12:12 encourages us to "be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."
 - Nurture a Hope-Filled Perspective. Allow the hope of eternity and God's promises to guide you through difficulties, motivating you to serve Him even in the face of loss.

- Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 reminds us of the strength in unity: "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up."
 - Connect with Fellow Believers. Serving God in challenging times is made easier through connections with fellow believers. Lean on your Church family for support and encouragement.
- Galatians 6:2 instructs. "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ."
 - Minister to others together. Use your collective experiences to uplift, encourage, and serve those who are also struggling, showing them the love of Christ.

- <u>James 1:12</u> reminds us, "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him."
 - Persist with Steadfastness. We must make a commitment to God that we will strive to example Christ-follower lifestyles. We must trust in God's guidance and the belief that perseverance in faith leads to spiritual growth and transformation.

- <u>Colossians 3:2</u> advises, "Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. "Subpoint 2: Setting Your Mind on Things Above
 - Set our minds on things above. By focusing our thoughts on heavenly matters rather than on the concerns of this world, we gain a perspective that helps better navigate challenges while still serving God with passion and purpose.
