

Locked Out of the Instant Church Directory?

If you have changed your email address, you may be denied access to the Church Digital Directory. Access is restricted to members only and is based on your email address as it was when you were added as a member. You may need to reset your directory.

- Go to the church directory icon on your phone
- Delete church directory icon from phone
- Go back to app store
- Search for "Instant Church Directory:
- "get" will come up; click on "get"
- This will reload the directory on your phone.
- You should be able to login using your new email address.

If that doesn't work:

Open the new instant church directory

Click on "Menu"

Go to "settings" and find "reset directory" and hit "reset" This should allow you to access the directory with your new email.

Major Messages from the Minor Prophets

September 17, 2023

Genesis 25:19-23 (NIV)

¹⁹ This is the account of the family line of Abraham's son Isaac.

Abraham became the father of Isaac, ²⁰ and Isaac was forty years old when he married Rebekah daughter of Bethuel the Aramean from Paddan Aram and sister of Laban the Aramean.

²¹ Isaac prayed to the LORD on behalf of his wife, because she was childless. The LORD answered his prayer, and his wife Rebekah became pregnant. ²² The babies jostled each other within her, and she said, "Why is this happening to me?" So she went to inquire of the LORD.

²³The LORD said to her,

"Two nations are in your womb, and two peoples from within you will be separated; one people will be stronger than the other, and the older will serve the younger."

 Though you soar like the eagle and make your nest among the stars, from there I will bring you down,"
 declares the LORD.
