



- - ♦ **Psalm 139:16** "You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed" (*NLT*).
 - Listen closely to what God says. After all, He literally knows the best decisions for us to make.
- II. _____- friends that you're born with
 - ♦ **2 Timothy 1:5**: "I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well" (*ESV*).

• **Deuteronomy 6:6-7**: "These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up" (*NIV*).

- ♦ The Bible often refers to our friends as our family.
 - **Psalm 133:1**: "Behold! how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity!"
 - **Proverbs 18:24**: "Friends come and friends go, but a true friend sticks by you like family" (*MSG*).
 - "My brother Jonathan, you have been very pleasant to me. Your love to me was extraordinary, surpassing the love of women." (2 Samuel 1:26)
 - Have you told your friends that you're thankful for them lately? Have you told God how thankful you are for them? If not, then do so.
- ♦ For different reasons, not everyone has any family members. But everyone can and needs to have friends.
 - **Proverbs 27:10**: "Do not forsake your friend or a friend of your family, and do not go to your relative's house when disaster strikes you—better a neighbor nearby than a relative far away."

- ♦ The reverse applies to us. We need to be the friend that God has called us to be.
 - **Job 6:14** "Anyone who withholds kindness from a friend forsakes the fear of the Almighty."
 - **Proverbs 17:9** "One who forgives an affront fosters friendship, but one who dwells on disputes will alienate a friend."
 - **Job 42:10** "When Job prayed for his friends, Jehovah restored his fortunes, giving him twice as much as before."
 - Never underestimate the power of prayer and forgiveness.

- We don't get to pick and choose who God adds to the church.
 Once He adds them to the church, they are our brothers and sisters
 - "And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved" (**Acts 2:47b**, *NKJV*).
- 1 **Timothy 5:1-2** "Do not rebuke an older man but encourage him as you would a father, younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, younger women as sisters, in all purity."
 - This is not a mere suggestion, but a statement of fact of what our roles are to be in the church.

- ♦ God is our Father
 - 1 John 3:1 "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are!" How? Galatians 3:26 says: "For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus" (*KJV*).

- ♦ God is our Brother
 - Jesus said that "whoever does the will of God, he is my brother and sister and mother" (Mark 3:35, ESV). Of course Jesus' physical family is important. But His spiritual family is even more important to Him.
 - **Hebrews 2:11** "Both the one who makes people holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers and sisters."
 - Coffman says: "That Christ is 'not ashamed to call them brethren' is a most instructive thought. That the sinless and perfect Saviour should not be ashamed of vile and sinful man, and through his great love for them, should consent to partake of all their sufferings, even death, and should even go so far as to receive them as his spiritual body and make of them his bride that must be hailed as an attitude of loving grace that beggars all description."
 - Christ will never be ashamed of his brethren but will confess them before God and his holy angels (Mark 8:38).
- ♦ God is our Companion
 - Acts 2:38 Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."
 - Peter did not say that you might or could, he said that you WILL receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
 - 1 Corinthians 3:16 "Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?"
 - **John 14:23** "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home [or "dwelling place", see *KJV* and *NASB*] with him" (*ESV*).
