

Discipleship and the Cross

Jesus linked discipleship to the cross with his statement in Luke 9:23 when he said, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take their cross daily and follow me."

Share

Study

In verse 26 of this passage Jesus speaks about being ashamed of him and his teachings. What does Jesus say are the consequences of making that choice, and what do his words mean to you?

Serve

Identify an action you will take this week to help someone you know needs help in this area. This should be more than just "I'll pray for that person"; it should be a way you can reach out to them personally in some way.
