

LEADER: NEAL PHARR LORD'S SUPPER AND OFFERING – I CORINTHIANS 11:23-29

LEADER: For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread,

ALL: and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me."

LEADER: In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying,

ALL: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." ²⁶ For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes

LEADER: So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.
