

Haggai 1:2–11 (NIV)

² This is what the LORD Almighty says: "These people say, 'The time has not yet come to rebuild the LORD's house.' "

³ Then the word of the LORD came through the prophet Haggai: ⁴ "Is it a time for you yourselves to be living in your paneled houses, while this house remains a ruin?"

Errors can occur in these automated systems that may end your deductions without warning. A good rule of thumb is to monitor your statements for any change you did not request.
