



Check bank statements for accuracy of automated donations

 Are church donations properly appearing on your bank statements?

If you give via the Website or Txt2Give, check your bank statements regularly to verify that donations are being deducted as you directed. Errors can occur in these automated systems that may end your deductions without warning. A good rule of thumb is to monitor your statements for any change you did not request.



For December, any canned vegetables and boxes of stuffing are requested. Other non-perishable items are also welcome. Monetary donations allow MOH to buy meats and produce. If you give a check, make it payable to North Tampa Church of Christ and designate MOH in the note section of your check. We will send one check from the church to MOH at intervals, depending on the number of donations. Your generosity is very appreciated and vital to providing meals for hungry people in need.
